

Background

The Eric and Danielle Beverly Scholarship Fund was established in 2006 to recognize outstanding student-athletes graduating from Munising High School and extended in 2018 to recognize outstanding student-athletes graduating from other Alger County high schools. The annual program awards two (2) one-time grants each academic year. The recipients must be student-athletes who have demonstrated leadership and academic excellence during their high school career. Preference is given to students who plan to pursue a baccalaureate degree in a medical-related field. Awards will be sent to the applicant's selected college/university on their behalf. Applications are available in the spring of each year.

Eligibility

In order to be considered for the Eric and Danielle Beverly Scholarship Award, a student must meet all of the following criteria:

- The individual must be a graduate of Munising High School or any other school in Alger County who will graduate in the spring of 2020 and will be enrolled full-time in an accredited 4-year college or university in the United States for the 2020–21 academic year.
- The individual must have earned a varsity letter during his/her high school career.
- The individual must possess a minimum 2.75 GPA.
- The individual must demonstrate both academic excellence, as well as, outstanding community service through activities, volunteerism, and work experience.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated on the strength of their academic performance, leadership, and participation in athletics, extra-curricular activities, community involvement, career and educational aspirations, and the strength of their personal statements. Financial need may also be considered.

Selection Procedure

All completed applications will be reviewed against the program criteria by a selection process determined by the Alger Regional Community Foundation. Decisions are final and binding.

Application Instructions

- Read the application carefully and complete all sections.
- Be sure to include a typed personal statement of 500 750 words expressing how your experiences as a student-athlete are shaping your educational and career goals, why you should be considered for scholarship support and any financial or other information you wish to share that may be of importance to the selection committee in their review of your application.
- Include three (3) letters of reference from an appropriate teacher, coach, or other school/community representative.
- Include your high school transcript.
- Sign the application.
- All applications must be returned to designated person by the pre-determined date.
